



Terms and Conditions - 2024

New Students

All new and prospective students will need to meet with Rachel and Jay first at 2 Mount Drive, to ascertain the student's level and needs, decide on the best teacher, and answer any questions about lessons. After that, we will commence a four week trial period: lessons will need to be paid for in full before each lesson, and at any time during this period, both the student or teacher may terminate lessons, if they are not working. At the end of a successful trial, we will move to our subscription system of invoicing before the beginning of every month.

Fees

Kids weekly - £100 per month

Monthly subscription (4x 30 minute lessons)

Trial lessons cost £25 each

Weekly is the minimum we teach younger students.

An adult must attend lessons with younger students.

Adults fortnightly - £80 per month

Monthly subscription (2x 60 minute lessons)

Trial lessons cost £40 each

Adults weekly - £160 per month

Monthly subscription (4x 60 minute lessons)

Trial lessons cost: £40 each

Adult one off lesson/s - £60 each

(1x 60 minute lesson)

For students who don't want regular lessons.

It is also possible to organise more lessons, or lessons of longer duration, if you wish. Fees are to be paid in advance by bank transfer before or on the first of every month. An invoice will be emailed to you a few days beforehand. Setting up a monthly direct debit is recommended if you are on a monthly subscription.

Lesson Slots

Piano lessons with Jay happen on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. Singing lessons with Rachel happen on Wednesdays, Thursday mornings, Fridays and Saturdays. We are closed on Sundays and Mondays. If you are on a subscription, your lesson will be on the same day, and at the same time, each week or every fortnight. Please be punctual and on time - we cannot make up for lost time if you are late!

Books and Materials

All students are responsible for the purchase of any music books, backing tracks, theory books, apps, concert tickets, exam fees, etc. that they may require while having lessons. We do provide many free notes and pieces in PDF format too, which students can either print out at home or use on a digital device. Please remember to bring all of your current materials along to each lesson and a note book.

Minors

All students under the age of 16 will need to be accompanied by **one** parent or adult guardian for the full duration of the lesson. Please note that we do not have the space to accommodate any extra siblings or family members.

Cancellations

We hold a 48 hour re-scheduling policy.

If you need to re-schedule, please try to give us a minimum of 48 hrs notice to avoid losing your lesson. We will always aim to reschedule the lesson in that same week, if possible, or add the time to upcoming lessons in the future. Unfortunately, we can't offer any refunds for missed lessons. The fees that we charge cover more than just the lessons that we teach, and include lesson planning, designing and creating teaching materials, custom arrangements and pieces for students, as well organising and planning events and workshops.

If we can't make a lesson, for any reason including illness, we will attempt to either 1) reschedule it or redistribute the time; 2) Rachel or Jay might step-in and substitute for each other; or 3) we will refund the amount as a credit note for the next month.

Holidays

Please note that we don't follow any particular school calendar, so please always check dates if you are unsure. We normally take a 2 week break in April, August and December and will always give students plenty of notice. All important dates, including exams, courses, workshops, concerts and student socials, will be emailed to you at the beginning of each term. It might be possible to continue your lessons during these holiday periods - just ask your tutor if they'll be around. Please try to give us as much notice as possible if you are going to be away, so we can organise our timetable accordingly.

Stopping Lessons

Every student stops lesson at some point; this is perfectly normal. We ask that you give us **one month's notice** please, so that lessons can be rounded-off in a positive and thoughtful manner.

We reserve the right to stop teaching a student if, on a regular basis, they fail to practise, complete their homework, are consistently late, don't attend lessons on a regular basis, find that we have to often chase them for dates and payments, or if they behave in a rude, disrespectful or entitled manner. Good time-keeping, clear communication and mutual respect and empathy are greatly valued!

Personal Data

We will keep a copy of your name, email address and telephone number only on our database for the duration of your or your child's lessons. When you stop having lessons, we will ask you if you'd like to continue being on our mailing list or not. If not, all your personal data will be deleted.
